MONDIAL ASSISTANCE RISES TO THE SPORT RELIEF CHALLENGE ONCE AGAIN!

Once again Mondial Assistance volunteered its Call Centre services to take pledges for Sport Relief, and dealt with over 2,000 calls, taking a hugely impressive £54,564.17! Lisa Amor, Service Team Co-ordinator, took the largest amount of money on the night, reaching a grand total of almost £3,500.

Over 100 employees at Mondial House volunteered their Friday night to organise the event and handle telephone donations from 7pm to midnight. Donations made on the night, and throughout the campaign, will help change the lives of poor and disadvantaged people in the UK and around the world.

Over the next three years Sport Relief is committed to donating over £400,000 to charities around the Croydon area working with local disadvantaged young people - from those acting as young carers for their parents, to those with no home, or those being bullied. Volunteering as a Sport Relief call centre is therefore one more way Mondial Assistance is helping out in the local community.

To keep spirits high throughout the night, employees were treated to entertainment in the form of performances from Balloon Artist Andrew Smith, head and shoulder massages at desks, and sport-related challenges such as a Hula Hoop competition run by Virgin Active employees. Local businesses including Debenhams, Jury's Inn, Croydon Park Hotel and Tiger Tiger also provided raffle prizes and treats for goody bags, with a particular favourite coming in the form of decadent chocolate lollipops from Indulgence Confectionary, based in the quirky new undercover market, Stuff. food was provided by Simply Lunch and India Dining. All this guaranteed a successful and exciting night raising funds.
