Mondial wins ranking in the Top 40 Sunday Times Best Companies Survey for the fourth year in a row

Croydon based customer management specialists, Mondial, has achieved a place in the Sunday Times Top 100 Companies to Work for Survey. Mondial has this year been ranked 34th and is, in fact, one of only 17 companies that continues to be placed within the top 40 best companies since the creation of this prestigious accolade in 2001.

This award is designed to acknowledge best working practices, reflecting a company's working culture and employee satisfaction. Mondial was up against leading household names such as Capital One Bank, Honda UK, Nationwide, and American Express. Mondial was the only company in its field to rank in the top 100, and the only company in Croydon to achieve a place on the list.

The Sunday Times Top 100 has a high calibre of entrants, due to the survey's rising profile. Each year, an increasing number of companies have put themselves forward for recognition. The evaluation process lasts nearly six months from start to finish and includes audits, interviews, compilation of reports and statistics and questionnaire surveys completed by individual staff members.

In addition to being ranked 34th overall, Mondial was placed 8th with regard to 'least work-related stress' and 89% of staff praise the positive energy of the Chief Executive, Mike Webb - the ninth-highest score in the survey.
